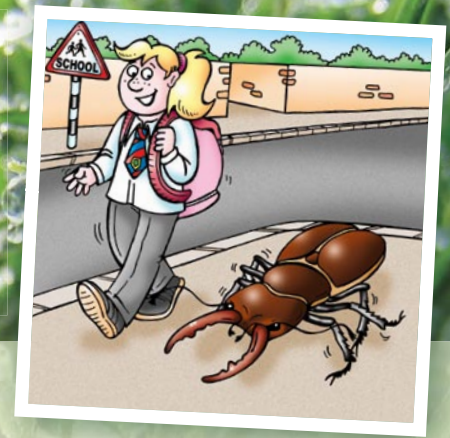


# Come and Walk with Beetles!
